

NEXT STEPS

Congratulations on your acceptance to Jacksonville University!

Below is a list of the next steps you need to take in order to complete your admissions process.

❑ ADMISSIONS DEPOSIT

In order to move forward with your enrollment at Jacksonville University, you must pay a \$300 tuition deposit at <https://apply.ju.edu/apply/status>. Within 48 hours of receiving your deposit, you will receive a JU username and password by email. Students may only sign up for housing and classes after their deposit has been received. If you are using military benefits, your deposit may be waived. Please contact veterans@ju.edu for more details.

❑ ORIENTATION

All incoming undergraduate students should register for new student orientation at <http://ju.edu/orientation>.

❑ FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid is available to students who have been: offered admission, determined eligible, filed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), classified as a degree-seeking student, and met all other eligibility requirements. For all forms and deadlines, please contact the Office of Financial Aid at <http://ju.edu/FinancialAid/>. Those using Veteran education benefits should contact veterans@ju.edu.

❑ FINAL TRANSCRIPTS

You must submit the official, final transcripts from each institution you have attended no later than six days after the semester begins. Your admission is incomplete until all final, official transcripts are on file.

❑ TRANSFER CREDITS

College-level credits with the grade of a C or better from regionally accredited institutions will transfer. However, all your credits may not meet your specific degree requirements. The department of your major will determine how these credits will be applied. Transfer credits will be evaluated after receipt of your admissions deposit.

❑ SCORE REPORTS

If you have taken AP, IB, AICE, or CLEP exams, you must have official score reports sent to the Office of Admissions for consideration of transfer credit.

❑ IMMUNIZATIONS

Prior to registration, you must submit a completed immunization form. The immunization policy and form may be downloaded from <http://ju.edu/files/Immunization-Medical-Form.pdf>.

❑ HOUSING

A variety of on-campus living arrangements are available to students. Housing info is available at <https://myroom.ju.edu>.

❑ DINING
